

**Colonoscopy Prep options**

You will be prescribed the prep which is on formulary with your insurance company. Some of the options are listed below.

“Hospital Prep” , the bag that was picked up from our office or the hospital, is unavailable for us to keep in stock due to a shortage of supplies.

There are alternatives to prep for your colonoscopy all of them will be picked up from your pharmacy.

**Sutab-** This prep is **pills only**

can be covered by your insurance with a copay, copay card available at [Sutab.com/savings](http://Sutab.com/savings)

Cost with Insurance and copay Card 40-60\$	
Copay with Part D medicare coverage Varies based on your plan	
Cash Price Up to 160\$- there are alternative preps with a lower cost; <b>there is a note on your prescription to use a lower cost alternative if you will be charged this amount</b>	

**Suprep or Clenpiq-** This is a **low volume prep**

can be covered by your insurance with a copay, there is no copay card available, you can try goodRx for a coupon

Copay with insurance Varies based on your plan	
Copay with Part D medicare coverage Varies based on your plan	
Cash Price Up to 125\$- there are alternative preps with a lower cost	

**Colyte / Gavilyte -** this prep is **1 gallon**  
 the **lowest cost**

Copay with insurance Varies based on your plan	
Copay with Part D medicare coverage Varies based on your plan	
Cash Price About 25\$
